### Thursday, January 31, 2019

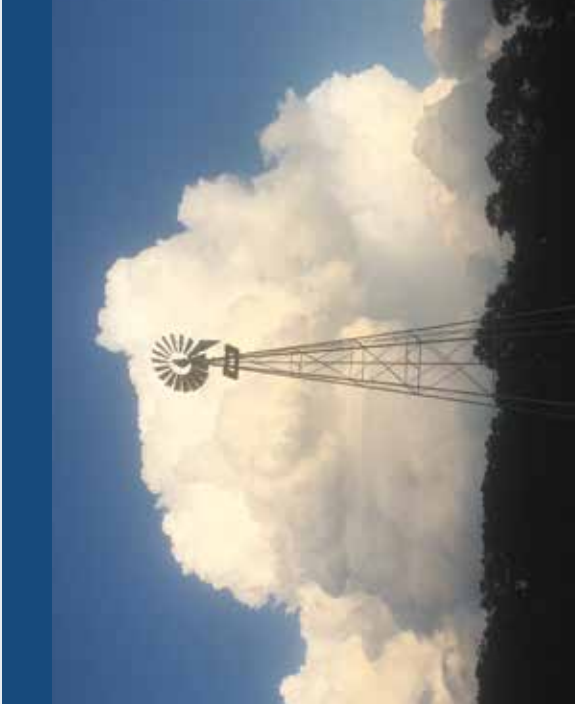
